Molly Aster	A young girl who is taken aboard the ship as precious cargo. Curious and intelligent, she will risk anything for the sake of what is right. Female. 13-25	
Black Stache	A notorious pirate, terrorizing the seven seas. Poetical and theatrical and quite flamboyant. Male. 30-50	
Grempkin	The schoolmaster of St. Norbert's Orphanage. Mean and malodorous, also plays Fighting Prawn, Mack and Sanchez. Male. 20-60	
Mrs. Brumbake Molly's nanny, a stereotypical British cad. Also plays the teacher. Male. 20-60		
Bill Slank	The vicious orphaned captain. Also plays Hawking Clam. Male. 20-55	

Smee	Black Stache's first mate. Single mindedly dedicated to his captain's every whim. Must play ukulele. Male. 25-55
Prentiss	An orphan, ambitious, hyper articulate and logical. Male. 13-25
Ted	An orphan obsessed with food. A natural performer with an easy wit. Male. 13-25
Alf	A seafarer, an old sea dog proud of his tenure. Male. 50-65
Lord Aster	Molly's father, a loyal subject to the Queen. The very model of a Victorian English gentleman. Male. 50-70
Captain Scott	Lord Aster's old school friend and captain of Britian's fastest frigate. Male. 50-70

Ray, 20's

a pro swimmer, an Olympic contender, and he has the body that comes with it; seems quite a bit dumber than he really is, surprisingly good at getting people to do what he wants; there's something dog-like about the guy, scrappy-but-endearing while at the same time there's the potential for some vicious violence. Note: Ray wears a Speedo and nothing more for the duration of the play.

Lydia, 25-

ex-physical therapist; lost her license for selling black-market pharmaceuticals; Ray's ex-girlfriend, feels quite betrayed by the guy for being spineless; she's a tough lady, a little more mature than Ray; she would really like to see Ray admit he's wrong and make things right.

Peter, 30-

Ray's brother, a lawyer; over being a lawyer, and would like to quit and make a new career in sports management; quick on his feet; his mouth moves fast and his brain even faster; quite important that he not be at all slimy; like his brother, grew up poor and fought to make a more comfortable life for himself.

Coach, 40s, maybe older Ray's coach, for a very long time; a kind of father figure, old pro, steady, but never quite had the break-out success he wanted; at first he seems to be the moral center of the play, but as the story progresses, his code of ethics shows some serious cracks.
